Museum staff are adults that can answer my questions or help me if I get lost.


I will keep my shoes on in the Museum.

I will walk and not run in the museum, and will use my inside voice.










One exhibit we might visit is the Happy Paws Hospital.

In the café, I can pretend to be different people. I can be a server, a host, dishwasher, or a chef.




When I am

On the other side, I can build puzzles, I look at books, hang laundry on the clothes line or just chill with the ducks in the pond.


